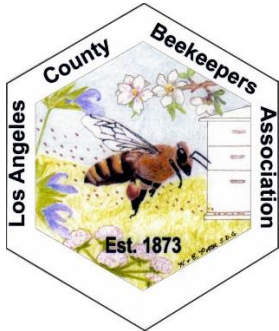


IMPORTANT! - APRIL Meeting Cancelled. Until further notice, all meetings will be online. The April 19th Beekeeping 101 class will also be online.

Message: I am selling my bee trailer with 10 colonies on it. Each colony has a screened bottom board, a double deep brood chamber, a queen excluder, a shallow honey super (which currently has honey being collected), a hive top feeder, an inner cover and a telescoping outer cover included. The trailer is under the weight limits for needing brakes or special registration, and has good tires and a spare. It also has an integral folding stair for easy access. I'm asking \$5,000.00 for the trailer and colonies. I'm getting out of the bee business as I physically cannot lift the weight of full honey supers anymore, and am trying to start a meadery which is taking up a lot of my time. The bees are currently in Simi Valley.
